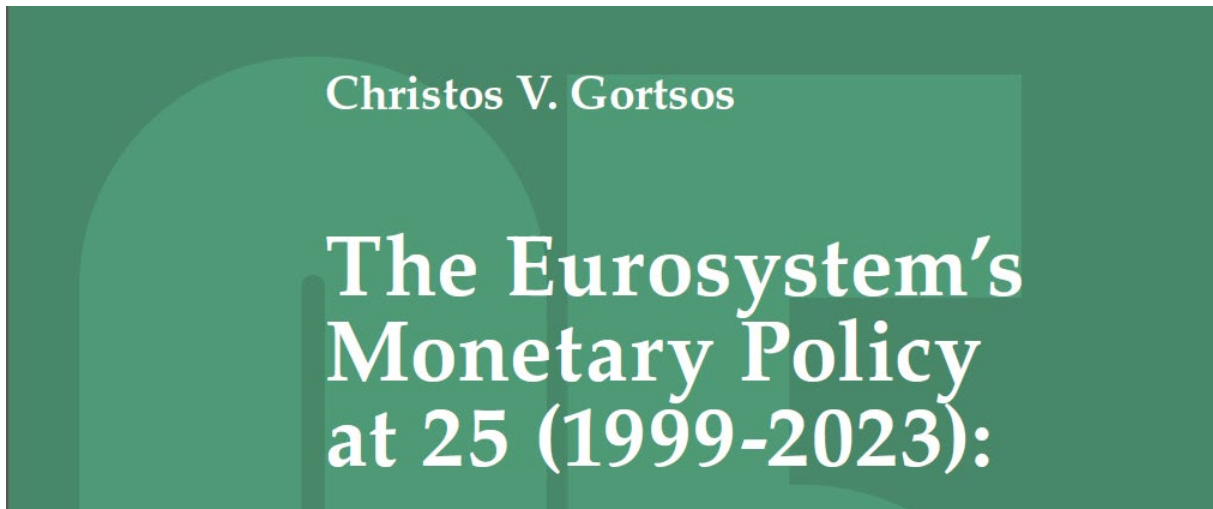


# Invitation to Book Discussion



The Center for Financial Market Regulation at the University of Zurich (UZH), together with the Europa Institut Zurich (EIZ) and the European Banking Institute (EBI) Frankfurt, is proud to announce a book discussion with the author Prof. **Christos Gortsos on 16 May 2025**. This book, completed in April 2024 and published by EIZ, aims to be a comprehensive and thorough analysis of the legal framework governing the definition and implementation of the single monetary policy in the euro area during the first twenty-five years of the Eurosystem's operation, namely, from the establishment of the Eurosystem in 1999 to the 2023 banking turmoil.

The event will be introduced by Prof. Andreas Kellerhals (EIZ) and Prof. Rolf Sethe (UZH), who will also moderate the Discussants' Panel consisting of: Prof. **Chiara Zilioli** (General Counsel of the European Central Bank), Prof. **Seraina Grünwald** (University of St. Gallen), and Prof. **René Smits** (University of Amsterdam).
